Executive Summary (Question, Options, Recommendations):

This paper summarises the information on CHC Retrospective cases which has been submitted to NHS England as part of the Month 3 reporting cycle.

In short, the progress of clearing the retrospective CHC cases remains a concern.

- NHS England is now requiring all the outstanding case reviews to be completed by 30th September. (There is an unspecified penalty for those CCG which do not meet this deadline).
- If the CCG is not able to settle any claims which need to be paid before 31st March 2016, it will lose access to the centrally held national provision for these claims, and will need to fund the cost of these claims from its own resources.
- The Director of Quality & Nursing is urgently seeking assurances from the organisation which has been engaged to complete these claims, in order to ensure that the information received by the CCG regarding the progress of claim reviews is accurate and timely – and that the financial risk to the CCG is minimised.
