### PPG Members' Conference 2016

- 1. Working with Healthwatch North Lincolnshire to improve the effectiveness of patient participation groups (PPGs) in member GP practices has always been regarded as an important engagement priority by the CCG. There are currently four strands to this work:
  - Holding development sessions for individual PPGs;
  - Producing PPG induction packs tailored for individual practices;
  - Facilitating quarterly meetings of the North Lincolnshire PPG Forum (previously known as the PPG Chairs Group); and
  - Promoting an annual PPG Members' Conference
- 2. The first PPG Members' Conference held on 27 October 2015 was well attended and received positive feedback. The one significant criticism was that the three hour afternoon event allowed insufficient time for discussion in the workshop sessions and for PPG member networking. It has therefore been decided that the 2016 event to be held at The House Conference Centre in Scunthorpe on Friday 4 November should run from 10:30 15:30 to enable networking to take place during a buffet lunch.
- 3. The programme will include a mixture of plenary sessions and participative workshops. Four distinguished external speakers/workshop facilitators have agreed to participate, namely:
  - Dr Andrew Furber President, Association of Directors of Public Health – 'The role of primary care in promoting patient activation, prevention and self-care'
  - Richard Armstrong Head of Public Health and Primary Care, NHS England (North) – 'Implementing the General Practice Forward View'
  - Christopher Cherry Primary Medical Services and Integrated Care Inspector, Care Quality Commission – 'Reflections on the first round of new style GP practice inspections and the role of PPGs in the process'
  - Christina McArthur Implementation Consultant, National Institute for Health and Care Excellence – 'The work of NICE and its impact on improving the quality of services provided by GP practices'
- 4. Although primarily aimed at PPG members, given the scope of the programme and the quality of the speakers it is intended to extend conference invitations to any GP practice, CCG and public health staff members who may be available to attend.
