IH presented the report and outlined the latest financial position of Primary Care (summarised by Care Network) drawing on the practice specific direct expenditure that is attributed to individual practices held by NHS England and NHS North Lincolnshire. At the end of the first eight months of the financial Year (i.e. up to 30 November 2016) the main area of financial concern continued to be the prescribing budget, which has an overall adverse variance of circa £356.7k IH highlighted the risks around prescribing and stressed the need to	Decision : The content of the briefing paper was noted.
