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Update on Humber Coast and Vale Sustainability and Transformation Partnership

Partners across Humber, Coast and Vale have come together to develop the STP as a health and care system that has the will and ability to help its population start well. The Sustainability and Transformation Plan published in November set out the priorities to take this forward.

Since then partners have continued to work together to take forward the aspirations set out. Some of this work is taking place at a Humber Coast and Vale level and some at a Place level (ie North Lincolnshire)

Governance and support

The Strategic Partnership Board is now meeting bi-monthly with the next meeting taking place on the 14 June.

The STP Executive Group continues to meet monthly, bringing together the Senior Responsible Officers (SRO's) for each of the work streams. The next meeting takes place on the 7 June.

The Humber Coast and Vale Joint Commissioning Committee is now established and has met.

STP Workstreams

The key focus of the STP is delivery in place, however work continues on the key areas where we are working with all STP partners including;

- Mental Health
- Cancer which is being taken forward through the HCV Cancer Alliance Board
- In hospital services
- Workforce through the Local Workforce Action Board
- Strategic Commissioning

North Lincolnshire Update

As updated at the last meeting the key areas we are focusing on in North Lincolnshire include:

- Integrating health and care services and the development of an accountable care
 partnership with membership from Safecare Network, Northern Lincolnshire and Goole
 Foundation Trust, Rotherham, Doncaster and South Humber Foundation Trust and North
 Lincolnshire Council.
- Developing primary care and taking forward the implementation of the GP 5 Year Forward View
- Prevention, self-care and wellbeing working with all partners and the voluntary and community sector.

Recent Communication and Engagement activity

Feedback from the stakeholder workshop with health and care partners and the voluntary and community sector held on the 30 March at Arties Mill has been collated and shared with attendees.

The workshop considered 8 themes

Mental Health Services (all ages)

- Cancer
- Workforce (as an enabler)
- In-Hospital Services
- Prevention and Wellbeing
- Self-Care and Self-Management
- Integrated Services and Accountable Care
- Primary Care

The report identifies the key topics of conversation from across the eight different themes. A number of these support the detail of the current plan whilst others offer an opportunity to review areas where different views were expressed, as well as having the ability to further expand the Transformation Plan, as appropriate. Initial feedback suggested a number of key themes that arose during the workshop, these being:

- There is an appetite for integration, we just need to 'get on with it' including wider partners
- We need to clarify the voluntary sector role, there is a willingness to help but needs support
- There is a view that we need more focus on the prevention agenda
- Mental Health requires an 'all age' strategy and should include Social Prescribing
- There is a view that there should be less services provided in a hospital setting
- We need to embrace workforce opportunities across recruitment, apprenticeships & rotation
- Identified need for one SPA and one directory of services for professionals and public

Work is now underway to support the development of the STP delivery plans for North Lincolnshire including reflection of the discussion with stakeholders.
